

## **SUPPLEMENTARY POINTS (FOR OTHER EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES):**

When inconsistent performance has been observed on a student's evaluation components, efforts will be made to contact the student's sending school for clarification. When it has been determined by appropriate personnel that a student's score on a component was due to extenuating circumstances, then the student will be awarded points in the component that was affected by the extenuating circumstance(s), equal to the average of the proportion of points awarded in each of the other evaluation components.

If any score(s) are still unavailable, the remaining scores will be averaged without penalty to missing scores.
